### **NESTERS**

Like most of our Nests, Nest Athens is staffed by two types of volunteers:

- International Volunteers (teachers and other professionals from around the world)
- Local Volunteers (the population we serve – in this case, refugees and asylum seekers)

1. Make the commitment to do it! There is a 2-week minimum stay though we encourage you to stay longer.

3. Wait for your official confirmation.
4. Schedule your online 2-hour orientation.
5. Start packing!
